FAC...	Facultative Species: Equally occurring in wetlands or non-wetlands.
FACU...	Facultative Upland Species: Usually occur in non-wetlands, occasionally found in wetlands.
UPL...	Obligate Upland Species: Occur almost always in non-wetlands.

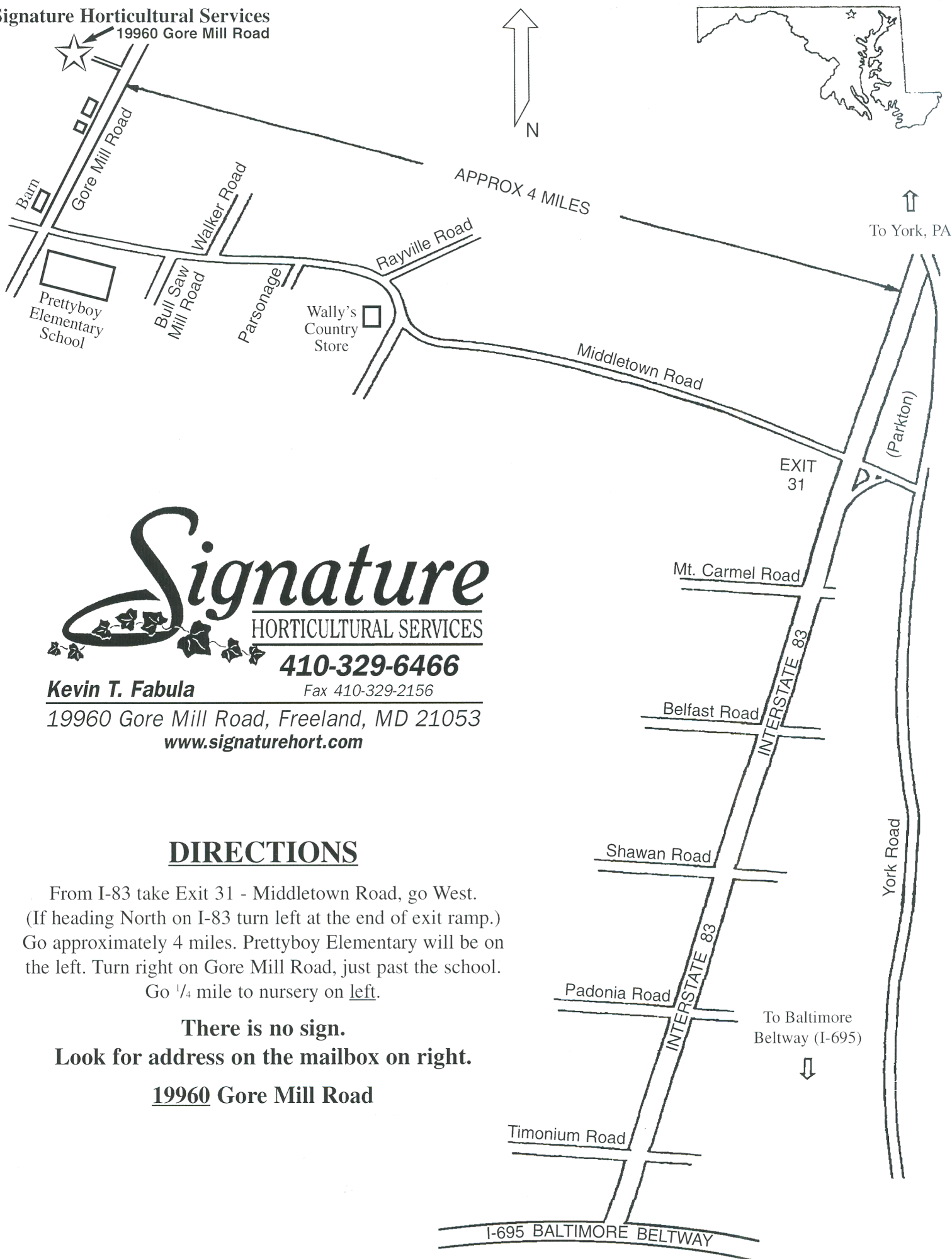
